Consultation: Green Paper on a Common Strategic Framework for future EU Research and Innovation Funding

On 9th February 2011, the European Commission presented a **Green Paper** which proposes major changes to EU research and innovation funding to make participation easier, increase scientific and economic impact and provide better value for money. The changes, to be introduced in the next EU budget after 2013, would bring together the current Framework Program for research, the Competitiveness and Innovation Program, and the European Institute of Innovation and Technology.

The Commission is seeking the views of all interested individuals and organizations on these proposed changes and on the specific questions set out in the Green Paper. The **deadline for contributions is Friday 20 May 2011**. In parallel, a competition for the name of the Common Strategic Framework is being organized.

- o An **online questionnaire** based on the Green Paper, in particular for interested individuals, companies, research institutes and citizens. The questionnaire has been designed to be quick to complete, and it is not necessary to answer all questions.
- o Submission of **written responses**, in particular for associations and large organisations that wish to provide in-depth views. Such responses will be published on this site immediately following their submission. Written responses should follow the structure and questions set out in the Green Paper. It is not necessary to respond to all questions, and additional ideas are welcome.
